

Advertisement for Appointment/engagement of CBI Special Public Prosecutors for High Court to conduct CBI Cases before the Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad at Allahabad and its Bench at Lucknow

The Special Public Prosecutors are appointed under the provision of Section 24(8) of Cr.PC, 1973 for handling cases of DSPE (CBI) before the Hon'ble High Courts. In this regard, applications are invited from eligible Advocates for the appointment / engagement of Special Public Prosecutors (Retainer Counsels for High Court) in CBI.

Fee Structure in respect of CBI, Special Public Prosecutors:

Professional fee of the Advocates will be governed by the terms and conditions contained in DoPT letter No.225/18/2023-AVD-II dated 24.01.2024 (copy attached).

Eligibility Criteria:

The following points may be kept in view while submitting the request for the appointment/engagement of CBI Special Public Prosecutors (Retainer Counsels for High Court) to conduct CBI Cases before the Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad at Allahabad and its Bench at Lucknow:

- 1. Educational Qualifications: LLB
- 2. Enrollment Certificate as an Advocate with the Bar Council.
- 3. Experience at BAR of handling Criminal matters in Hon'ble High Court.
- 4. An unconditional willingness/consent to work on the general terms and conditions approved by Government of India from time to time.
- 5. Details of important cases handled by the applicant Advocate.
- 6. A minimum standing of 10 years as an Advocate is required for considering an Advocate for CBI Special Public Prosecutor (Retainer Counsel for High Court) who have experience in handling Criminal Matters.

Period: Minimum 03 years.

Nature of Job:

To look after all cases of CBI Lucknow Branches and other Branches of CBI before the Hon'ble High Court of Allahabad at Allahabad and its Bench at Lucknow.

Documents to be submitted alongwith the application:

- 1. Educational Qualifications.
- 2. Enrollment Certificate as an Advocate with the Bar Council.
- 3. Experience at Bar for 10 years or more as an Advocate who have experience in handling Criminal Matters in Hon'ble High Courts..
- 4. An unconditional willingness/consent to work on the general terms and conditions approved by Government of India from time to time.
- 5. Details of important cases handled by the applicant Advocate.

The complete application in prescribed format alongwith the requisite documents should be submitted through online link. In case of incomplete applications and applications received offline and after the last date shall not be considered. Only shortlisted candidates will be called for an interaction by CBI.

3	Drafting fee per case for drafting, pleading, reply to petitions, ground of appeals etc.	Rs. 5000/-
(iv)	Clerkage in a case or batch of cases irrespective of number of hearings	10% of daily fee, subject to maximum of Rs. 3000/-
(v)	Out of pocket expenses in a case or batch of cases (till its final disposal payable on the bills)	Rs. 1000/-
