- a. ICSE : Girls have done better than Boys, pass percentage is : 99.21%**
 Boys have achieved a pass percentage of 98.71%
- ISC : Girls have achieved a pass percentage of 98.01%**
 Boys have achieved a pass percentage of 95.96%

- b.** The ICSE examination has been conducted in 63 written subjects of which 21 are Indian languages and 14 are foreign languages and 2 Classical languages.

The ISC examination has been conducted in 47 written subjects of which 12 are Indian languages and 3 are foreign languages and 1 Classical language.

- **14149 Scheduled Caste** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 98.36%
- **8248 Scheduled Tribe** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 96.92%
- **53251 Other Backward Classes** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 98.98%

- **4885 Scheduled Caste** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 96.15%
- **3710 Scheduled Tribe** candidates took the examination achieving a pass percentage of 95.58%

f.1 ICSE – Special Difficulty Cases

Candidates with Learning difficulty (Dyslexia etc) cases were **1034** (102 candidates obtained above 90%).

Visually Challenged cases were **35** (16 candidates obtained above 90%).

f.2 ISC – Special Difficulty Cases

Candidates with Learning difficulty (Dyslexia etc) cases were **216** (19 candidates obtained above 90%).

Visually Challenged cases were **17** (2 candidates obtained above 90%).
